Sandra initially hid her baldness underneath a wig for years; however, through much soul-searching, spiritual growth, mental fortitude and by using the foundation of principles she teaches as a Certified John C. Maxwell Leadership and Personal Development Coach, she reclaimed her confidence and turned that pain into a source of power. Today, Sandra uses her voice and artistry to advocate for autoimmune disease awareness and to promote women's empowerment. She equips others with the tools to embrace change and build the courage to be their authentic self regardless of the challenges. Sandra shifted her life experience from being a victim, to being victory personified and has authored the life changing book, "My Crown and Glory, It's Not about the Hair; Six Fundamental Principles to Heal Emotional Wounds and Build Healthy Self-Esteem."

In 2011, Sandra DuBose made North Carolina history when she competed bald in a statewide beauty pageant and was crowned – Mrs. Black North Carolina. Sandra became a local hero – and a role model for women (and men) of all ages. Through her leadership within the community, she has become a recipient of numerous awards, and has been featured on NBC, UNC-TV, PBS, Radio One, Essence, FOX 8 News and several other media outlets.
